



## Default Policy

Please note: Defaults are not good for anyone- it is our intention in implementing a default policy to avoid defaults from occurring.

This policy is intended as a deterrent – while it is each team’s prerogative to decide whether or not to play each week, it is our expectation that as part of the agreement we make in allowing your team’s registration, we will allocate a space for your team in return for your team attending and utilizing that space. Our business and the satisfaction of our entire membership are predicated on this agreement being honoured.

Defaults will be dealt with in the following manner:

Any team that defaults – which is failing to show up to play with the minimum number of players deemed necessary to play- will be required to do the following:

- Submit a \$50 “Default Bond” (by credit card or cash) within 48 hours of the default occurring. This default bond will be refundable at the conclusion of the current season, provided the team does not default again during that season. This default bond can be paid by contacting our office at 604-879-9800.
- **If the team does not submit the default bond they will not be eligible for priority re-registration in the subsequent season of play, meaning that they lose their right to keep their spot in the league for the next season.**
- If the team defaults a second time, the \$50 bond will be donated to Canuck Place, one of the charitable organizations that Urban Rec actively supports. The team will be required to submit a second \$50 “Default Bond” with the same consequences noted above should they fail to submit the default bond or default again.
- Urban Recreation, at its sole discretion, reserves the right to eliminate teams from the league without refund should they fail to comply with the above noted policy.
